What is Jump Canada?



Jump Canada is a committee of Equine Canada responsible for all hunter, hunter equitation and jumper activities in Canada from the grass roots to the international level. Jump Canada is governed by a board of directors, the majority of whom are elected by the stakeholders in the sport. There are 18 board members and 14 sub-committees that are responsible for the operation of Jump Canada with the support of technical manager Karen Hendry-Ouellette who works from the Equine Canada offices in Ottawa. A complete outline of the Jump Canada structure and responsibilities can be found on our website www.jumpcanada.ca.

CORE OBJECTIVES

1. To develop, build and grow Canada's hunter/jumper community at all levels.
2. To improve the effectiveness of communications to internal and external audiences.
3. To promote rider and horse development at an international level.
4. To administer and manage the Jump Canada organization.
5. To improve and increase funding and sponsorship base.

Since its inauguration in 1998, Jump Canada has initiated important national programs, fostered grass roots development within the provinces, fielded successful teams at World Championships, Pan American Games and Olympic Games and maintained financial responsibility.

Owners are particularly important to the success of show jumping in Canada. Through their support of the athletes and ownership of their horses, they make it possible for Canada to field competitive teams in international events. Their support is paramount to Canada's success and, each year, Jump Canada presents the Owner of the Year Award in recognition of their invaluable contribution to the sport.

Beginning his riding career in Hudson, Québec, at the age of 16, Jonathan Asselin moved out west to work for former Canadian Equestrian Team member Mark Laskin in Edmonton, then opened his own stable in British Columbia before becoming a resident rider for Spruce Meadows. Now Jonathan operates his own training business, Attaché Stables.

Solid performances and a win in the second Olympic Selection Trial in Bromont, QC, resulted in a ticket to Sydney for Jonathan and Spirit of Xerox II, a Hannoverian gelding owned by Spruce Meadows. After helping Canada finish in the top ten, Asselin went on to finish tied for fifteenth individually.

Jonathan is married to Nancy Southern. The couple resides just outside of Calgary with their three children, Kelly, Kyle and Ben.

Jonathan is also a member of Team Molson, formed in 2004 as Canada's first sponsored show jumping team.

Erynn began riding at the age of five at Looking Back Farm with her parents, David and Sandi Ballard. One year later, she entered the show ring and there was no turning back.

Erynn's first international success came at the 1996 North American Young Riders' Championship where, riding Ordinary Man, she earned a team bronze medal. The following year Erynn and her mount, Raphaella, became the first horse/rider combination to capture all four classes comprising the junior/amateur division at the 1997 Royal Winter Fair. In 1998, at Madison Square Gardens, Erynn became only the second Canadian to win the ASPCA Maclay National Championship given for excellence in flat work and jumping.

In 1999, Erynn captured the Individual Gold Medal at the North American Young Riders' Championship with the seven-year-old Irish-bred gelding, Leacock. In 2003, the pair enjoyed their first grand prix victory together, winning the \$30,000 Pin Oak Grand Prix in Texas.

Recognized for her ability to ride all types of horses, Erynn is often the pilot of numerous mounts in the Young Horse Development classes. She also has several promising Grand Prix mounts in her stable.

Born in Miami, Frankie began riding at the age of four and has successfully competed in the western disciplines of barrel racing and team penning. Her first taste of international jumping success came at the 1997 North American Young Riders' Championship where Frankie captured Individual and Team Silver medals with Braveheart.

Although Frankie has a large string of international caliber horses, she owes her initial grand prix success to Ravenna Z. At age 17, Frankie was selected to represent Canada at the 1998 National Horse Show in New York, making her the youngest Canadian to ever ride on a Nations' Cup team. In 2001, Frankie was a member of the Canadian Developing Riders Tour, which allowed her to gain valuable experience competing in Nations' Cup events on the European show circuit.

Frankie furthered her European education by spending the majority of the 2004 season based in The Netherlands and Belgium. That European experience paid off with great results at the 2005 Winter Equestrian Federation, and a spot on Canada's Nations' Cup Team.

Show jumping runs in the family – her father, Alan, was also a successful show jumping competitor. Always on the road with a hectic competition schedule, Frankie finds time to volunteer in her hometown of Orangeville.

Following a very successful riding career as a junior, Harold Chopping has ridden in more than a dozen Nations' Cups since being named to the Canadian Equestrian Team in 1988 and has represented Canada in three World Cup Finals. He was also the alternate at the 1992 Barcelona Olympic Games.

With the exception of the annual Spruce Meadows tournaments in Calgary, AB, Chopping spends the majority of the competition season showing in the United States. A career highlight came in April of 1996 when he won the prestigious \$100,000 Budweiser Grand Prix in Florida with his talented Belgian-bred gelding, Brandy.

After spending a few years out of the limelight, Harold made his presence known by helping Canada claim victory in the 2004 Nations' Cup in Wellington, FL, riding the talented mare, Kathleen. The pair were again members of the Nations' Cup Team at the prestigious CSIO Spruce Meadows Masters Tournament where Canada placed third, marking the home country's best finish in over a decade.

Chopping, who has one daughter, is currently riding for Silver Oaks Stables in Hampton Falls, New Hampshire.

Having been a steady performer at the international level for over 30 years, Mac Cone is one of Canada's most experienced riders. Originally from Tennessee, Mac moved to Canada in 1979 and is the only rider to have competed on both the United States and Canadian Equestrian Teams.

Riding the Hannoverian stallion, Elute, Mac won the 1996 Olympic Selection Trials and, in his Olympic debut in Atlanta, was the highest-placed Canadian rider. It was a feat he would repeat at the 2002 World Equestrian Games in Jerez, Spain, riding Cocu. Mac's current grand prix string includes the two grey mares Melinda and Cybella, a half-sister to Cocu. At the 2004 Royal Horse Show in Toronto, Mac was named the Leading Canadian Rider while Melinda was named the Leading Canadian Horse.

In addition to his own riding, Mac is recognized for his coaching abilities as he has trained 1986 World Champion Gail Greenough and 2003 Pan American Games contender, Mark Samuel. Married to Canadian Brenley Carpenter, the couple has two daughters and operates Southern Ways Stable.

Mario began riding at a young age and, in 1984 at the age of 19, became the youngest rider to ever win the World Cup Final, a record he still holds today. He was also the first Canadian to ever capture the title. Later that year, at the Olympic Games in Los Angeles, he was involved in a three-way jump-off for the individual bronze medal, eventually finishing fourth.

A two-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion, Mario has represented Canada at every major international event. While competing at the 1999 World Cup Final, Mario was awarded his World Cup silver medal, signifying that he has competed in over 100 World Cup Qualifying competitions.

Mario spends a great deal of time based in Germany, returning to Canada to his home base of Bromont Equestrian Centre, site of the 1976 Olympic Games equestrian competition.

A natural athlete, Kimberley Farlinger spent her youth participating in track and field and equestrian sport, but her love for horses eventually won out. After competing in local equestrian shows, Kimberley had the opportunity to train with renowned Canadian Equestrian Team member Jill Henselwood, and quickly saw her career skyrocket from the amateur divisions to the top levels of the sport in less than two seasons.

Kimberley attended high school in Owen Sound, Ontario, where she graduated with honours. In her spare time, she enjoys downhill skiing and music while her career objectives are clearly fixed on representing Canada in future international competition.

The most successful competitor in the history of Canadian show jumping, Ian Millar has represented Canada in over 90 Nations' Cups, is a nine-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion and was the first rider to ever win back-to-back World Cup Final titles in 1988 and 1989 with the legendary Big Ben. With eight appearances, Ian has competed at the Olympic Games more than any other Canadian athlete in any sport. In 1986, Ian was awarded the Order of Canada and was named Ontario's Male Athlete of the Year for 1989. In 1996, both Ian and Big Ben were inducted into Canada's Sports Hall of Fame.

Ian remains at the top of his game, and is among the top finishers in almost every class he enters. In Athens, where Ian was Canada's sole representative after the Canadian Show Jumping Team failed to qualify for the first time in its history, he and Promise Me progressed all the way to the individual final. With several quality grand prix mounts, including his Athens Olympic partner and his 2004 Canadian Show Jumping Championship mount, In Style, Ian continues to be a force to be reckoned with.

Ian makes his home at Millar Brooke Farm in Perth, Ontario, just outside of Ottawa, with his wife, Lynn. Their two children, Jonathon and Amy, have both been Canadian Show Jumping Team members.

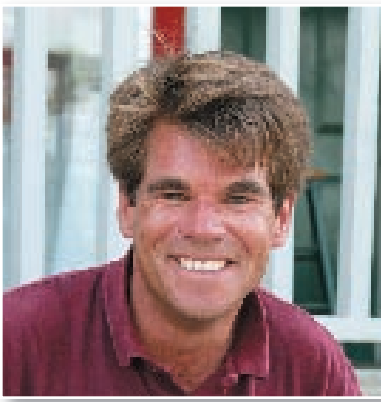

As a teenager, Underhill earned top honours from the Royal Conservatory for her singing, but it was her love of horses that won out. First named to the Canadian Equestrian Team in 1990, Beth has ridden in over 25 Nations' Cup competitions and, in 1993, was the first woman to win the Canadian World Cup League, a feat she repeated in 1999. With her retired partner, Monopoly, Beth earned more than \$1 million in the show ring.

A veteran of Pan American, Olympic and World Equestrian Games, Beth has claimed the Canadian Show Jumping Championship title on three occasions - in 1994 and 1996 with Monopoly and in 1999 with Altair. The same year, they finished second in the richest show jumping event in the world, the \$800,000 du Maurier International held at the CSIO Spruce Meadows Masters tournament where Beth was also named the Leading Lady Rider.

Beth is now enjoying grand prix success with Magdaline, the mare she rode to victory in the 2004 World Cup Qualifier in Bromont, QC, and the \$25,000 Collingwood Grand Prix. Beth operates Beth Underhill Stables in Schomberg, Ontario.

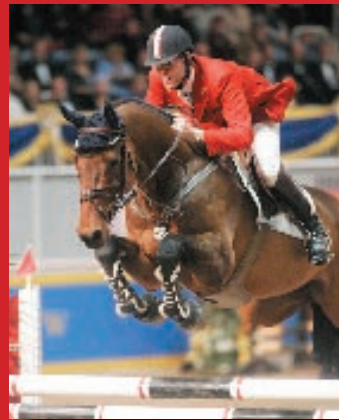
